11. 2 pairs of comfortable shoes to include tennis shoes appropriate for physical activity (no sandals or flip-flops during the daytime activities).

13. Stamps and stationery (if you plan to write to someone)
14. You may want to bring money for novelties; however, it is not recommended that you bring more than \$25.00.
15. Belt (No overly large belt buckles)
16. Cadets are requested to bring school supplies for donation to the Community Service Project.
17. Dark color permanent marker (to label issued t-shirts)
